Housekeeping

Welcome to our newly refurbished Arts Theatre Cambridge after undergoing an extensive and expensive transformation and as such the main auditorium, Visiting Company rooms have been remodelled to a very high standard. Please help us to keep it that way by taking all care and due diligence when moving yourselves or equipment through these areas. Please respect at all times the instructions from the in-house team and please report all housekeeping issues/damages as soon as they arise. Thank You.

Access:

The main entrance to the Theatre is found on Peas Hill via our Box Office reception. This entrance is open from 10:00 am every day and access to backstage is via a coded door. Stage door is manned on Fit up days from 8:00 am. But at all other times please use the main entrance.

The building operates a Salto electronic access entry system that visiting tech company may need to obtain a card for access to certain areas. These will be issued by the tech team and signed for. If they are not returned a charge will be incurred to the visiting company.

Parking:

Please note that we do not have any on site parking facilities. There is a pay car park for cars only just around the corner from the theatre, but we have no facilities for vans, minibuses etc to be parked near to the theatre apart from whilst unloading.

The nearest paid car park is at the <u>Grand Arcade</u> which is open 24 hours a day. This car park is quite expensive

The council runs 'park and ride' buses until 20:00 from several locations around the city.

There are a number of side streets where parking is free for the day, all of these are 15-20 mins walk from the theatre.

Internet:

Internet and WiFi connections are available backstage and on stage please ask a member of the Tech Dept for access password.

Dressing Rooms/Welfare

We have 8 dressing rooms and a band room. Three dressing rooms are large (up to 6 people) and three are small (1 to 3 people). There is also an accessible dressing room with ensuite at stage level. The band room can be used as 2 dressing rooms if needs be (up to 8 people in each). Some of the dressing rooms have showers and toilets ensuite, other showers and toilet facilities are available close by. There is no designated visiting company office.

There is a small kitchenette with microwave and fridge in the Green Room area with Tea and Coffee making facilities.

Wardrobe:

There is a wardrobe room and a laundry room with 2 washing machines, 2 tumble dryers.

Please note that any Laundry equipment that creates heat will not be able to be left on overnite. Hot Boxes must be kept in the dock area due to low ceiling height in dressing room area.

Prompt Desk:

GDS Prompt desk with paging facility located in stage left wing.

12 way Q-light circuits (patchable)

Fully integrated comms both hard wired and wireless available.

Video camera and monitors – colour and infa red.

Additional MD camera available on request - hire fee applies.

Stage:

The Stage is flat (no rake) and has a glazed black ply surface. Visiting Companies may fix directly into the floor with screws at the discretion of the in-house staff.

Flying system:

46 single purchase counterweight bars and 2 'up and down' bars, one either side.

(Max. spread load 500kg; max. point load 125kg)

Length of bars 10,200mm + 900mm extensions

Max height of bars14,000 mmMin. height of bars1,000 mmMax point load from the grid:1 ton per 3m

We carry 6 spreader beams in the grid.

Please note that all bars may not always be clear before a fit up commences. If a full de rig is needed for your show, this may incur an extra cost. Please enquire for these costs.

Seating

The front two rows of the auditorium (rows A and B) can be removed, to form a full Orchestra Pit. We will presume that these rows will be sold unless we are told otherwise by your company in advance.

We can provide access treads to the auditorium at either side of stage but each set of treads will require a loss of two seats from row A. Please inform us of this requirement as soon as possible

Lighting Equipment:

Within the lighting Bridges is a full LED Front of house rig consisting of 20 ETC Source 4 LED S3 Lustr, with XDLT 15-30° lens tube. These are not removable from the bridges. Plan is available on request.

We have a generic tungsten in house rig consisting of 30 x Cantata 1ks, 30 x Parcans with various lamp options and 40 x Source Four profiles with various lens options.

We also carry led battens and a very limited number of moving lights. Please submit your lighting plans to confirm numbers of generics and please enquire regarding moving lights and hire fees.

We are a Tru 1/Socapex house with regards to all in house plugging up. A number of adapters are available. Please enquire to secure these.

We carry an in-house stock of Gobos. Please e-mail with your requests for these and we will confirm hire costs.

Colour not in stock, other brands of colour filter or large quantities of filter can be supplied, and will be charged for at cost in addition to the colour call charge.

Please note that our House dimmers need to remain on universe 1 to allow use of our house lights. Please contact if this is an issue
