

Noël Coward's *Easy Virtue* Supernumerary Application Pack

As part of The Arts Theatre Cambridge's reopening season we are delighted to be producing Noël Coward's *Easy Virtue*, directed by Sir Trevor Nunn. We are looking for a mixed group of supernumeraries, with a playing age of 18-25, to appear on stage as guests at a party in the 1920s. They will have brief, costumed appearances, be seen dancing and chatting, crossing the stage, but they will not have scripted, audible lines.

There will be a casting call with the Associate Director on **Saturday 31st January from 11am to 2pm** in Cambridge.

Supernumeraries will be on a rota and will not be expected to attend more than 6 shows per week. For evening performances, they will be called at the theatre no earlier than 8pm, or 3pm on matinee days. They will receive a nominal fee of £6 per performance. Please note that travel expenses cannot be covered.

Successful applicants **must** be available to attend the casting call, rehearsals in the w/c 16 February in Cambridge, and for the majority of performances. Please review the performance schedule below before applying. Those invited to meet will be sent an appointment time and venue, and further information about what to expect in the meeting.

We welcome applicants from all backgrounds. No previous theatre experience is required.
